3. Terms and Conditions of the Visit:

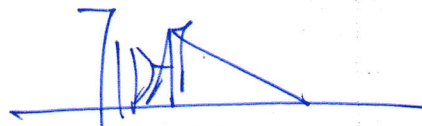
a. There will be no financial involvement of the University or the Government of Bangladesh in this visit.

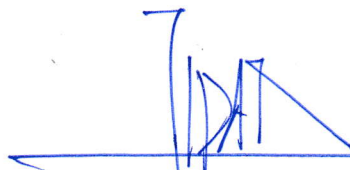
